As part of a transition project known as NEHEN 3.0, MHDC is expanding NEHEN to incorporate HL7® FHIR® (Fast Healthcare Interoperability Resources)* APIs, offering even more options for healthcare organizations to streamline operations, enhance interoperability, and meet regulatory requirements. Adding FHIR to the existing X12 EDI services will provide a single environment to meet multiple data exchange needs.




